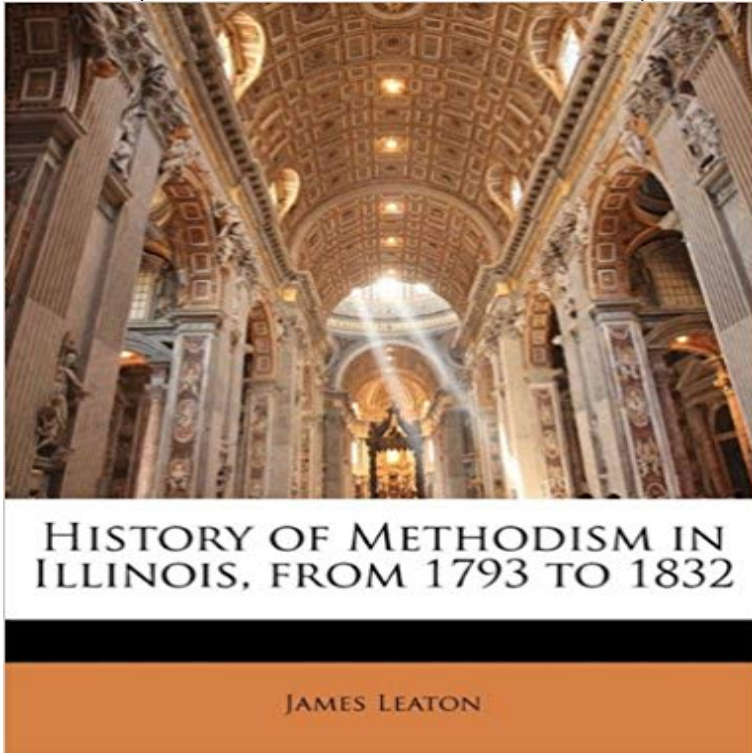


## History of Methodism in Illinois, from 1793 to 1832
