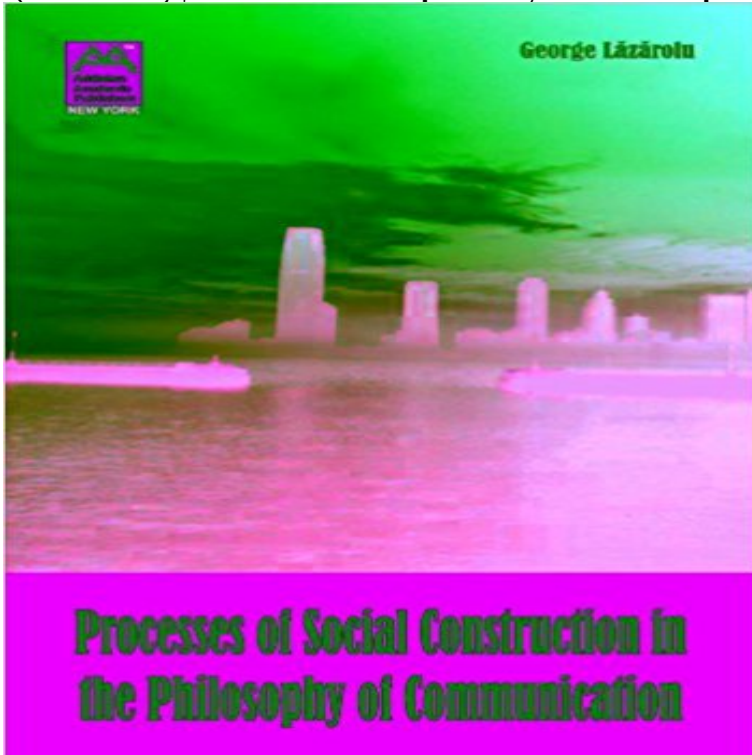


Processes of Social Construction in the Philosophy of Communication (Readings in Contemporary Philosophy)



This book discusses the major trends in scholarship about the increasing diversification of the multimedia environment, the transnational flow of political information and ideas, the mass-mediated public sphere, and the industrial infrastructure of media production and distribution. The objective of this book is to emphasize the importance of the relevance of fact-seeking in journalism, the changing nature of participatory media production, the information explosion of 24-hour news, and the contemporary networked news environment. I am particularly interested in exploring the crucial role of the media in processes of democratization and consolidation, the media's ability to contribute to democracy or good governance, the idea of media as a platform for democratic debate, and the media's impact upon democracy and governance. The results of the current book converge with prior research on the lived realities of today's citizen-consumers, the fragmentation of and experimentation with identity common in online communication, the social function of feature journalism, and the essential nature of media as the invisible interlocutor of people's lives.
