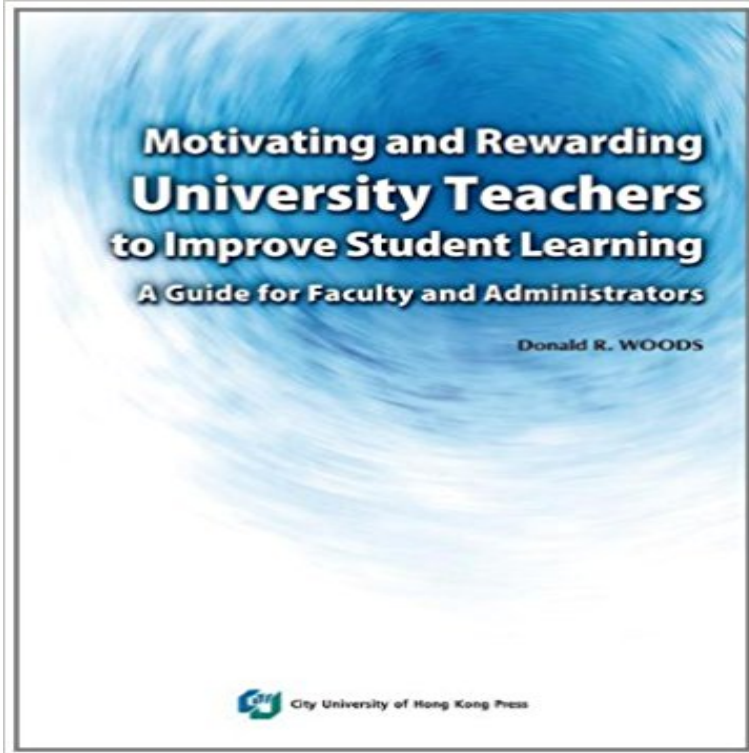


Motivating and Rewarding University Teachers to Improve Student Learning: A Guide for Faculty and Administrators
