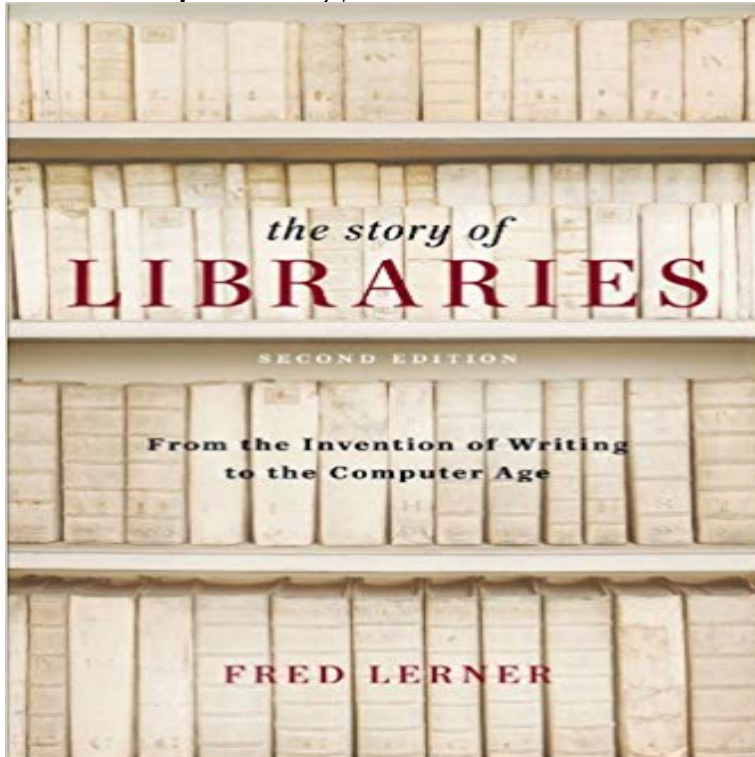


# The Story of Libraries, Second Edition: From the Invention of Writing to the Computer Age
