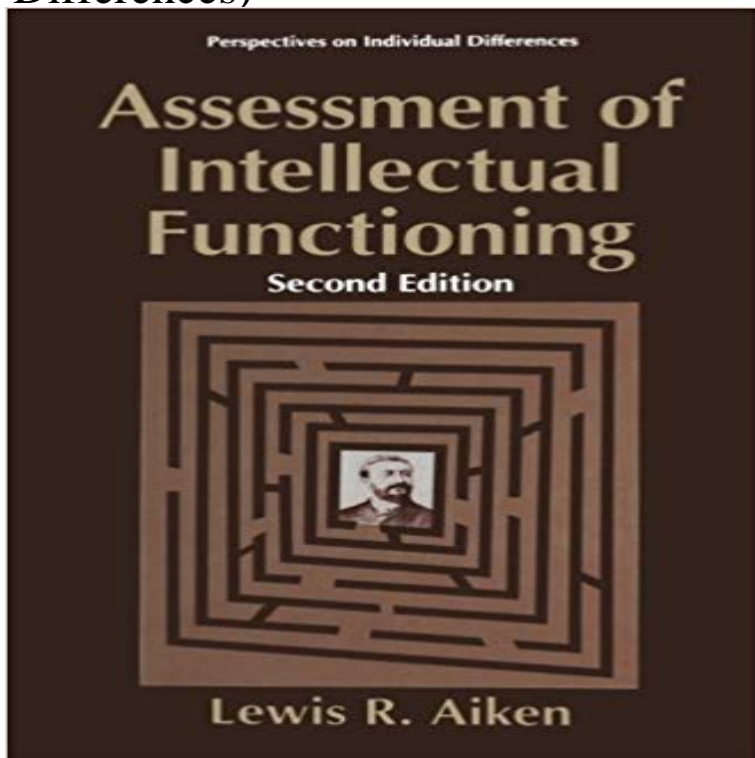


Assessment of Intellectual Functioning (Perspectives on Individual Differences)
