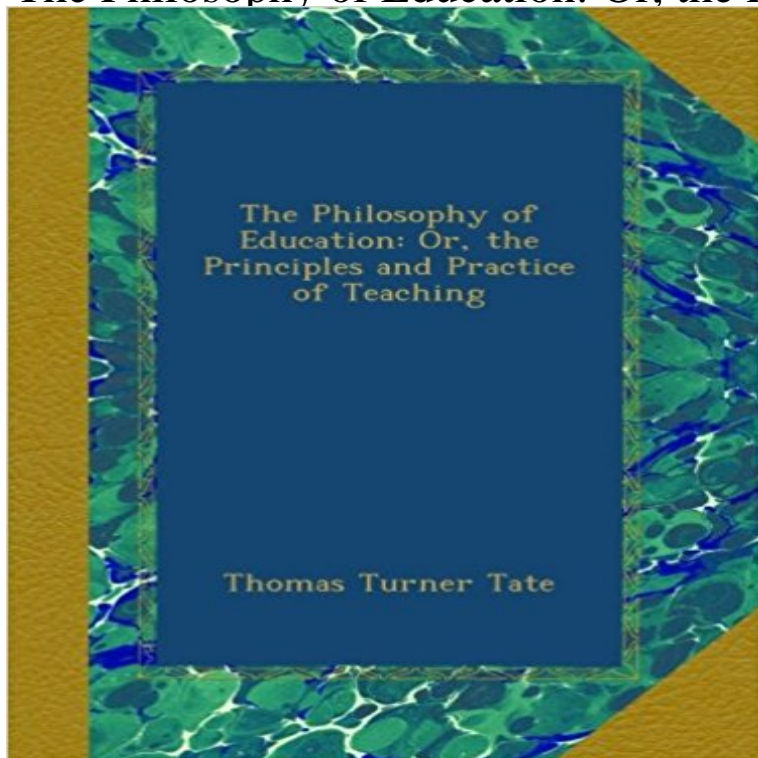


# The Philosophy of Education: Or, the Principles and Practice of Teaching
