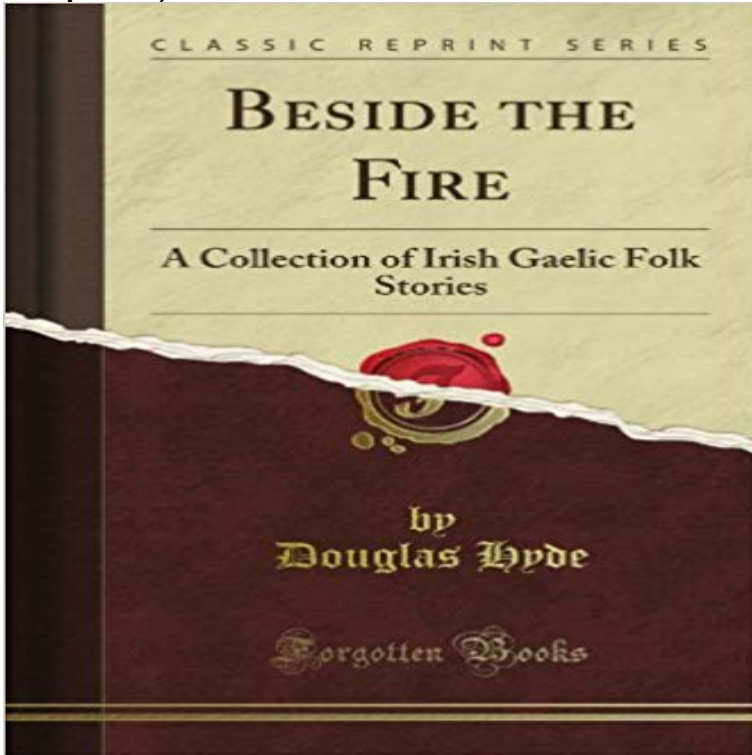


Beside the Fire: A Collection of Irish Gaelic Folk Stories (Classic Reprint)
