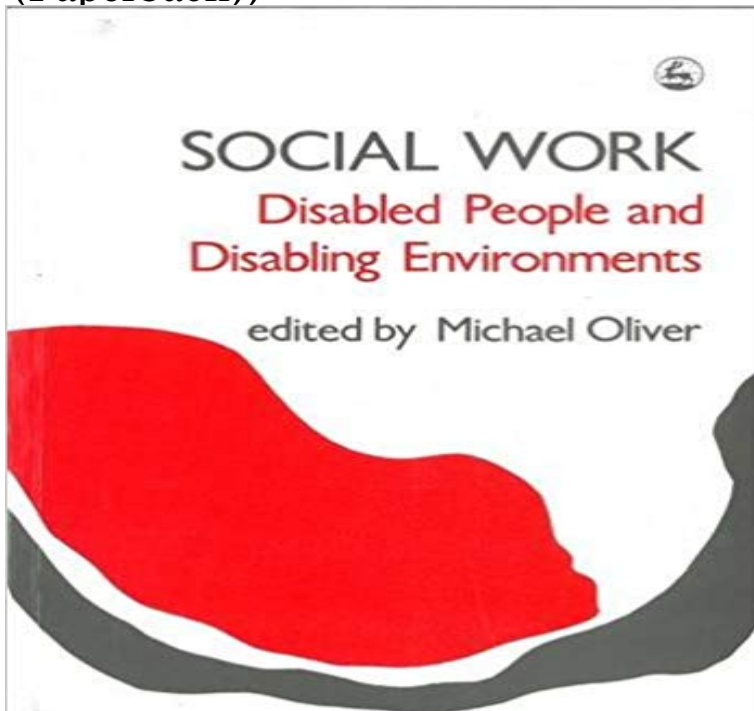


Social Work: Disabled People and Disabling Environments (Research Highlights in Social Work) (Research Highlights in Social Work (Paperback))
