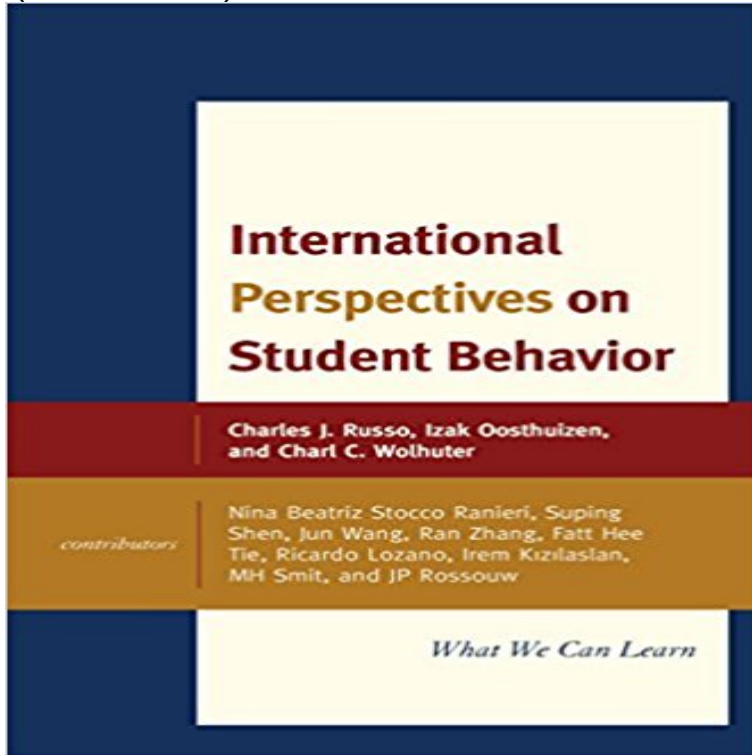


# International Perspectives on Student Behavior: What We Can Learn (Volume 2)
