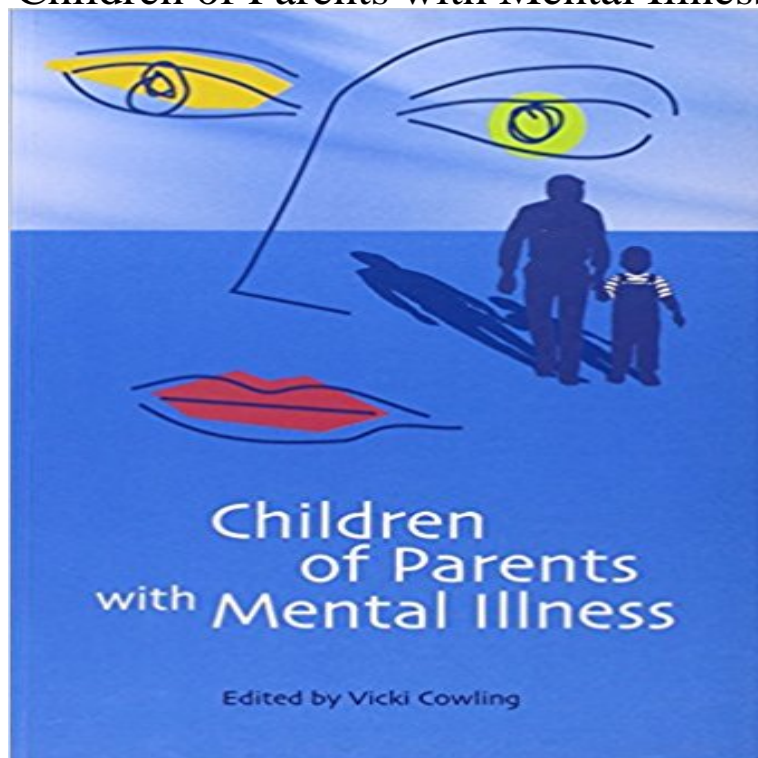


Children of Parents with Mental Illness
