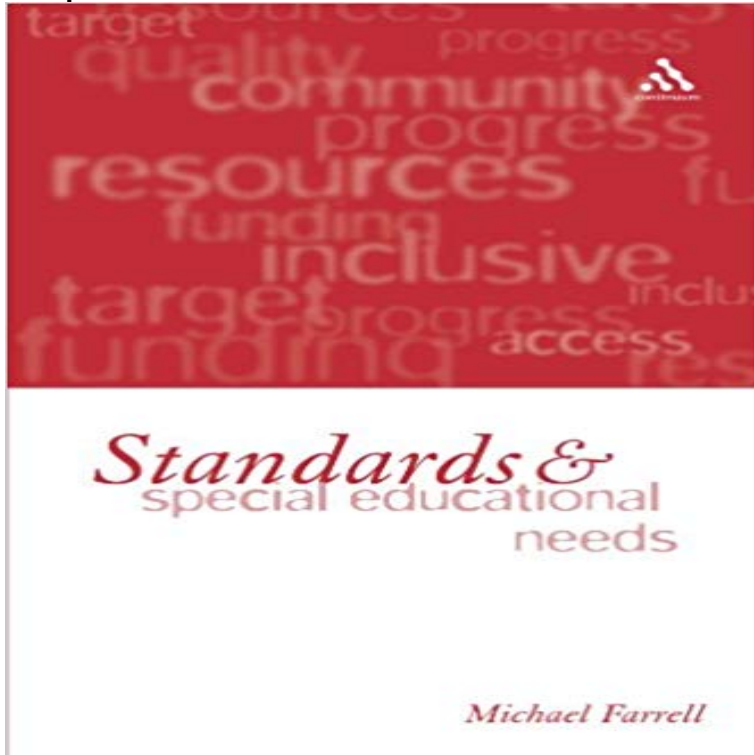


Standards and Special Education Needs: The Importance of Standards of Pupil Achievement
