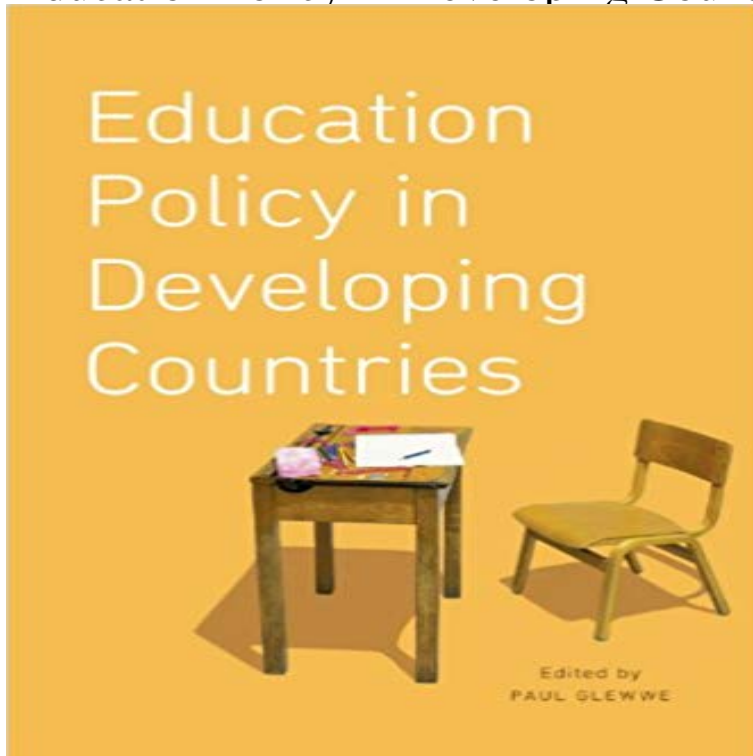


# Education Policy in Developing Countries
