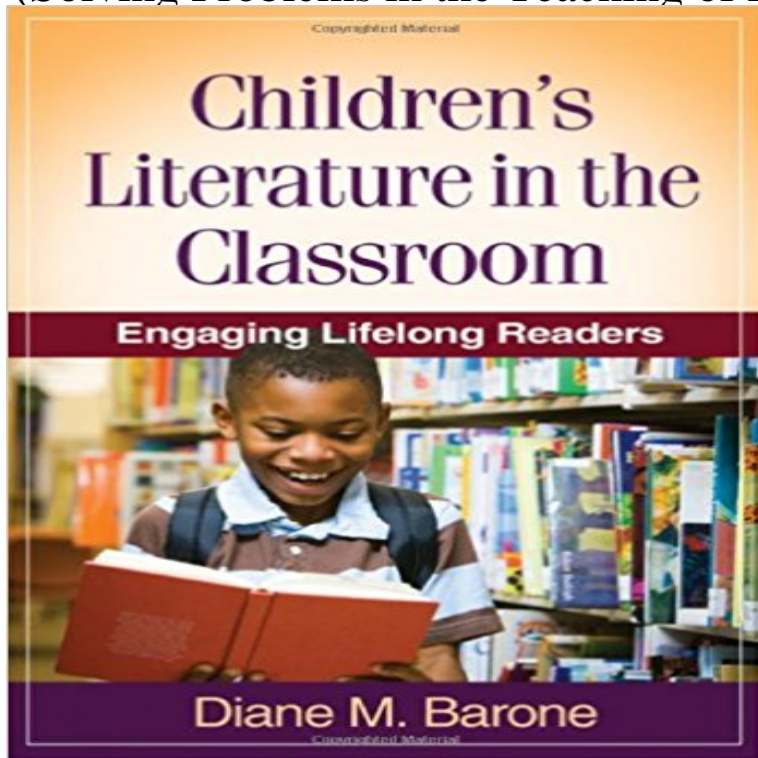


Childrens Literature in the Classroom: Engaging Lifelong Readers (Solving Problems in the Teaching of Literacy (Paperback))
