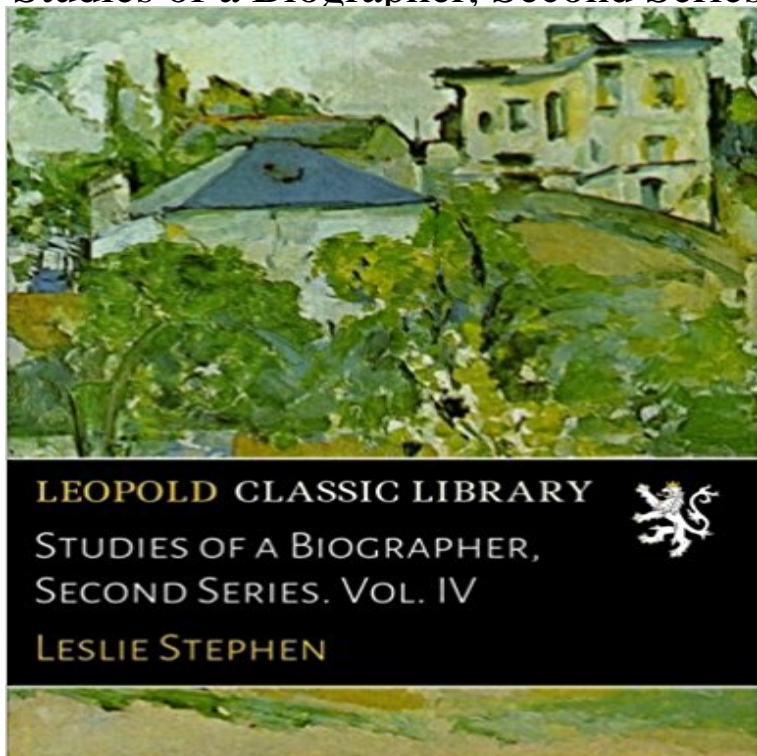


## Studies of a Biographer, Second Series. Vol. IV
