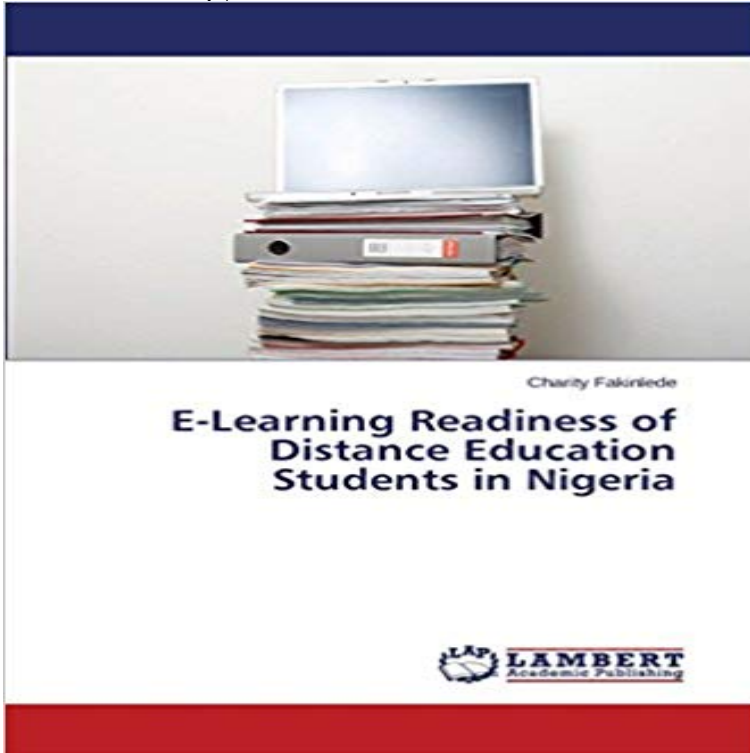


# E-Learning Readiness of Distance Education Students in Nigeria
