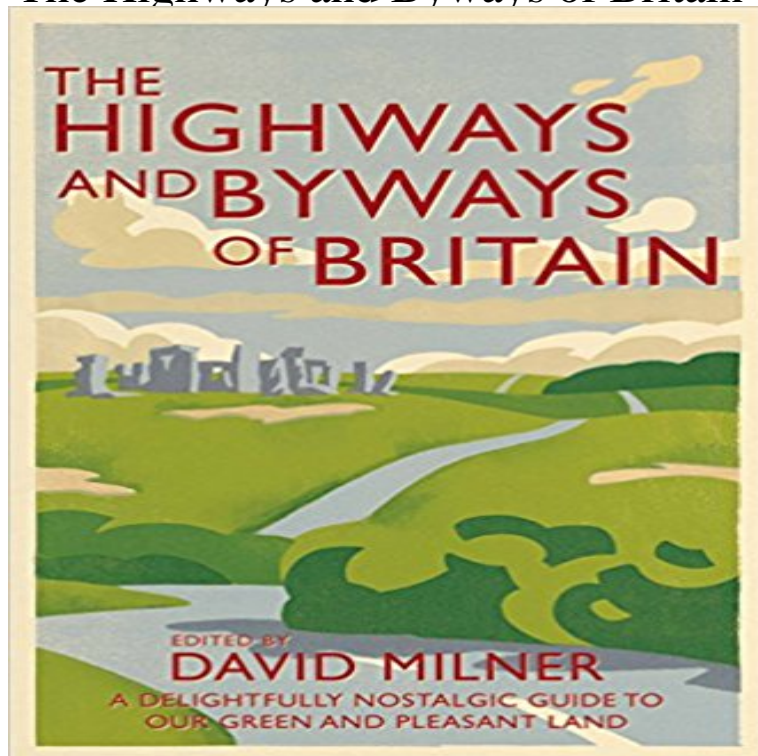


The Highways and Byways of Britain
