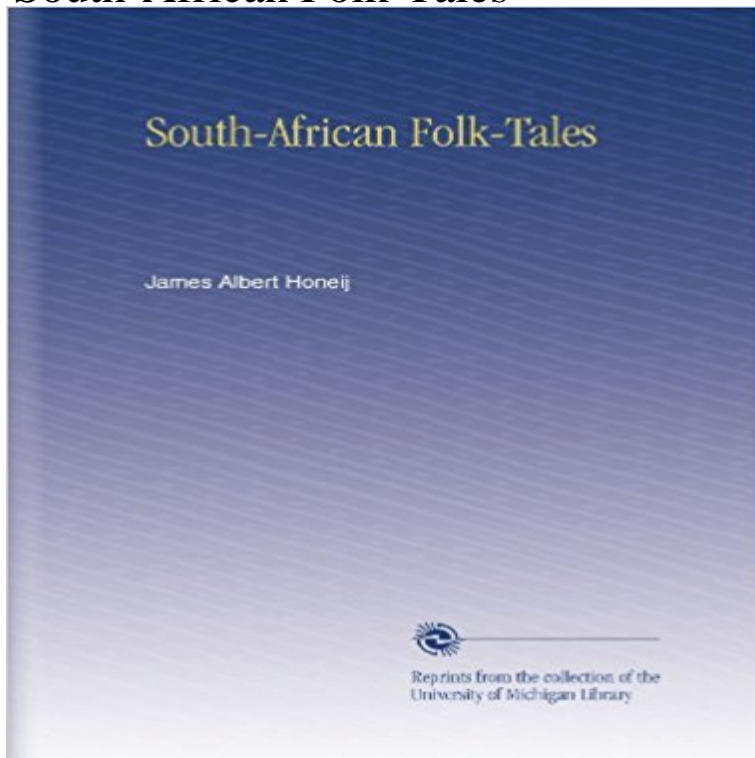


South-African Folk-Tales
