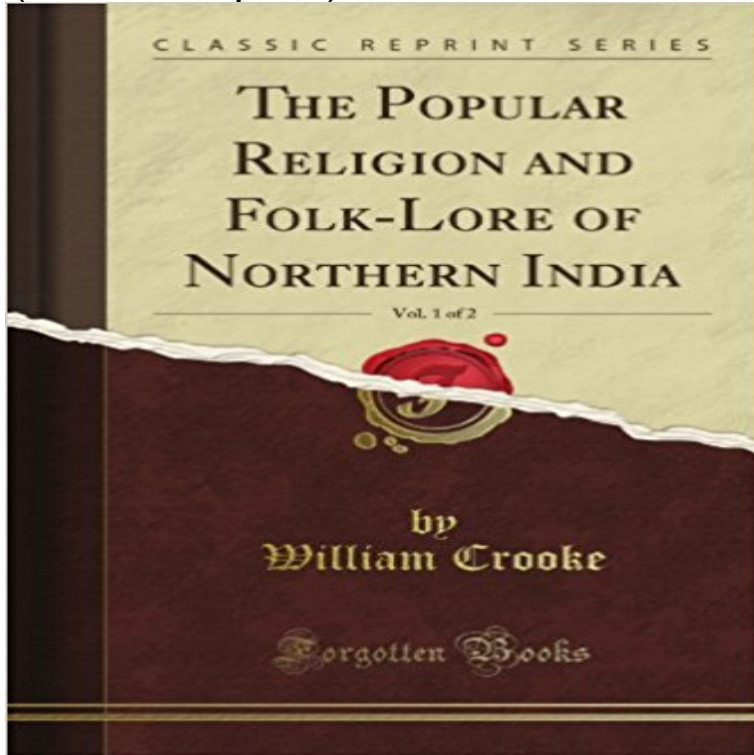


The Popular Religion and Folk-Lore of Northern India, Vol. 1 of 2 (Classic Reprint)
