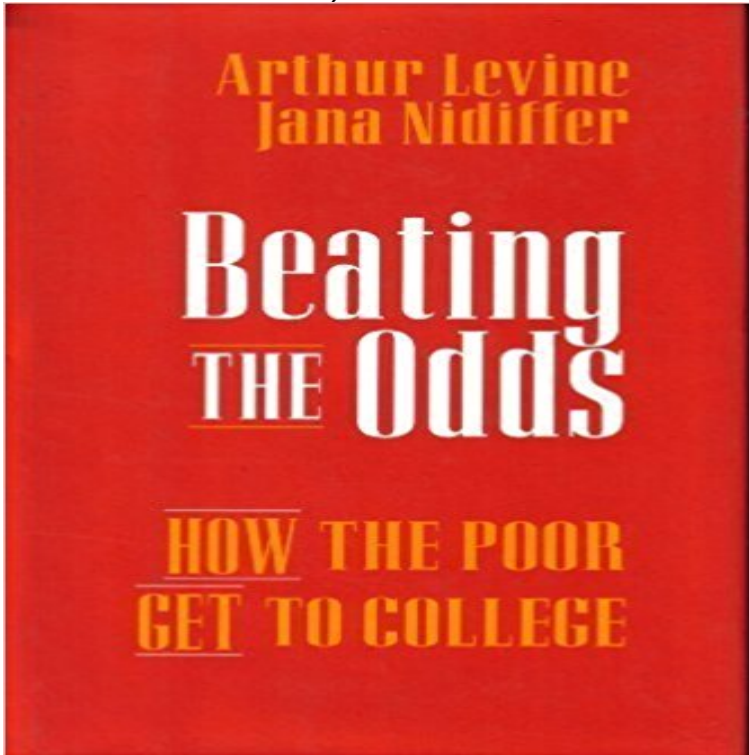


Beating the Odds: How the Poor Get to College (Jossey Bass Higher and Adult Education)
