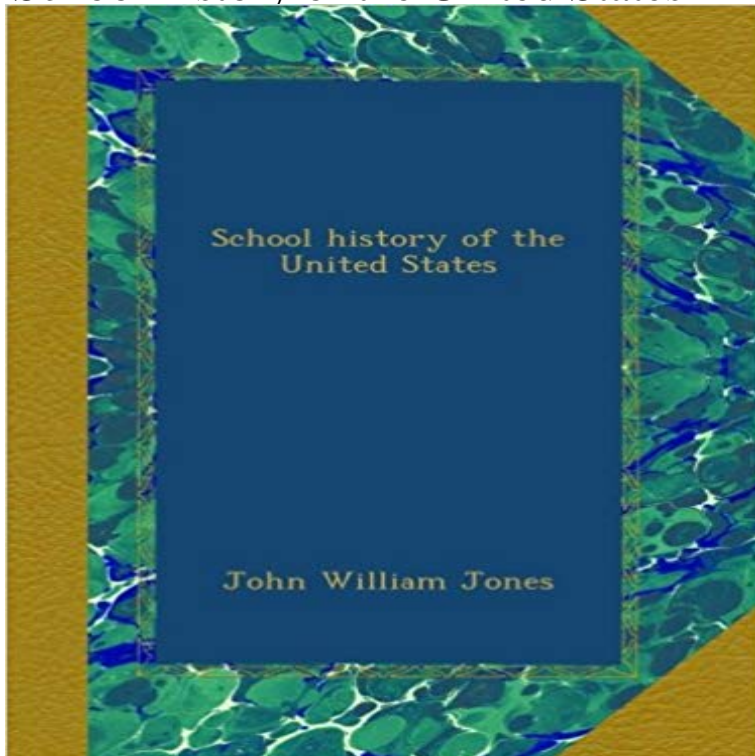


School history of the United States
