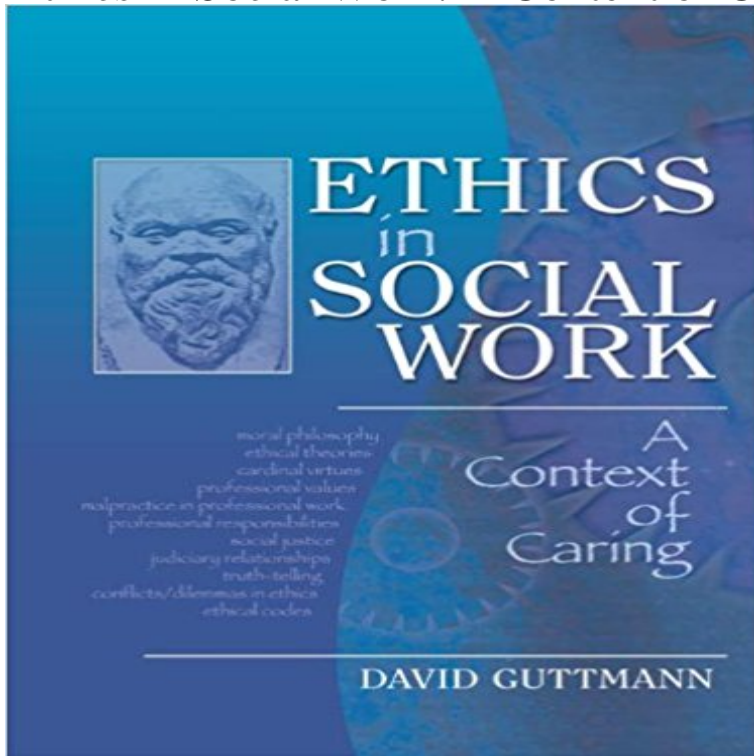


Ethics in Social Work: A Context of Caring
