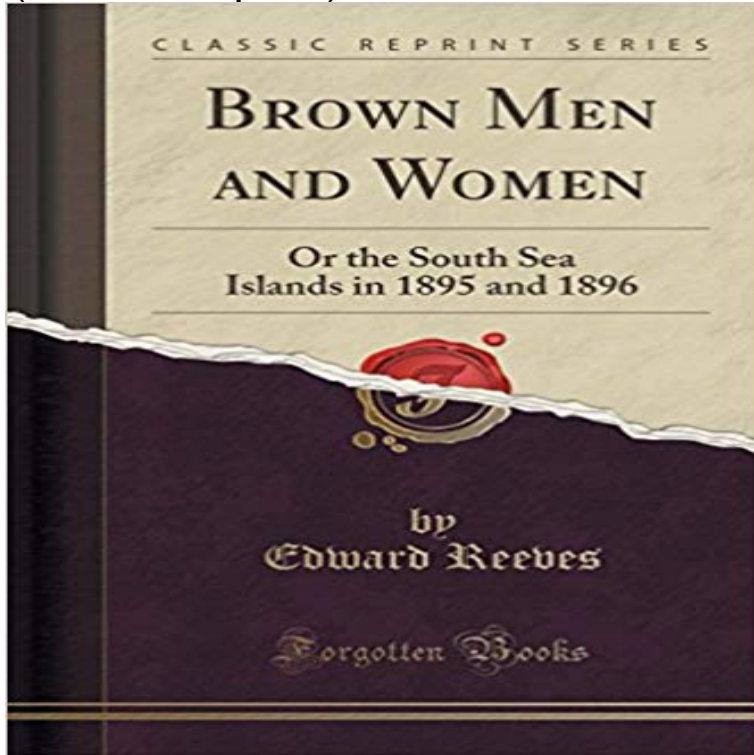


Brown Men and Women: Or the South Sea Islands in 1895 and 1896 (Classic Reprint)

At the new goldfield township of Hokitika, on the almost unknown, at any rate unexplored, west coast of the Middle Island of New Zealand, consignees waited long in vain. Then the brig *Sara/i*, or the clipper-built, topsail schooner *Rover*, was given up as lost with all hands. Insurances were paid. The sailors widows wept, and married again. The captain and crew died to New Zealand, and rose happily in the heaven of Tonga, Vavau, or Samoa. The *Rove*} was painted afresh, out of ships stores, or, may be, out of cargo. Her name was altered, a new set of papers forged, her cargo exchanged for pearl-shell and cocoanut-oil.
