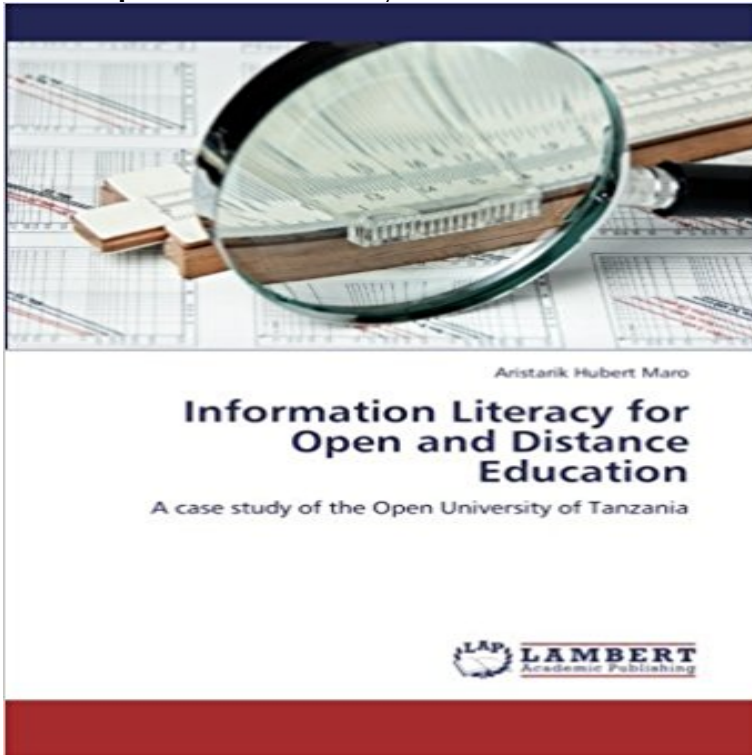


# Information Literacy for Open and Distance Education: A case study of the Open University of Tanzania



In an Open and Distance Learning (ODL) Mode, students are provided with printed and electronic study materials throughout their duration of their studies.
