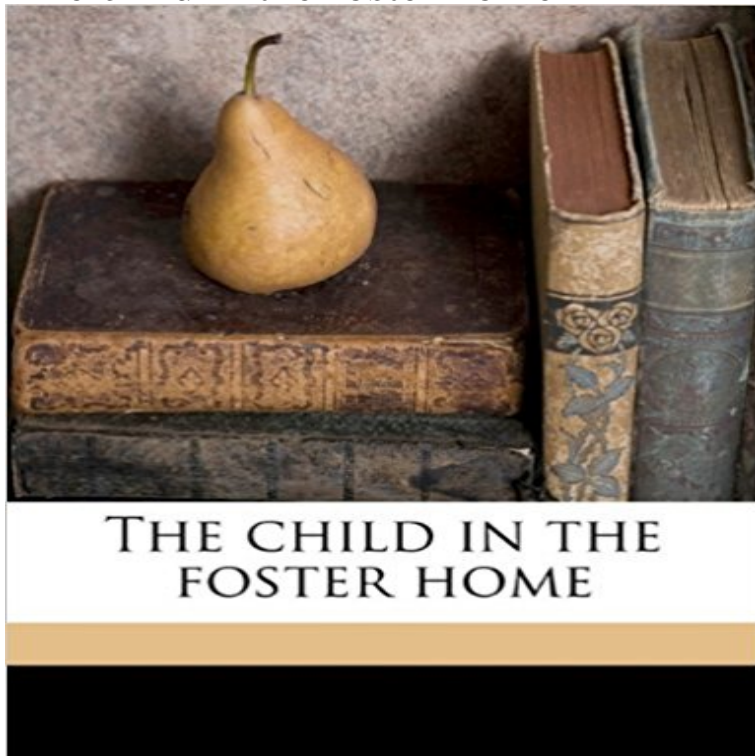


The child in the foster home
