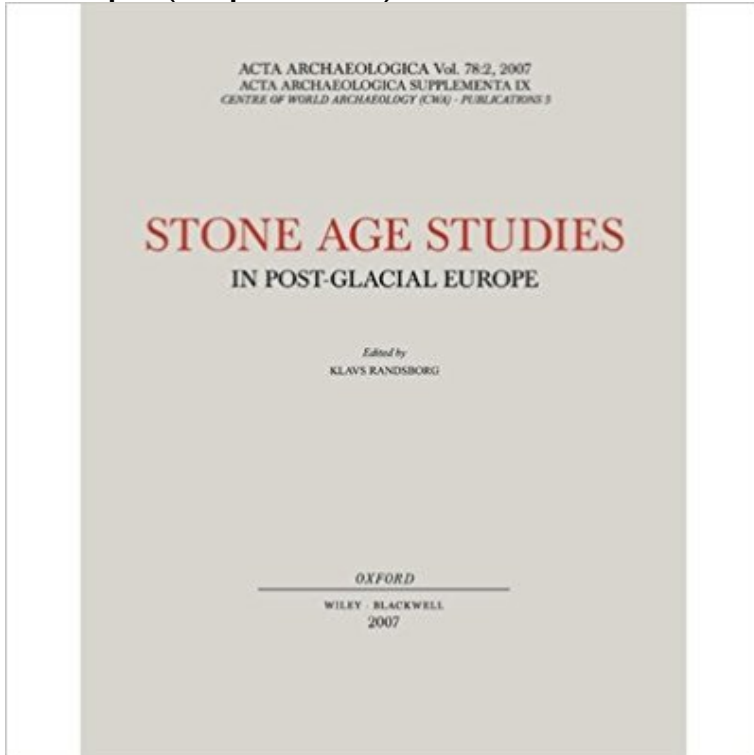


Acta Archaeologica Supplementa IX: Stone Age Studies in Post-glacial Europe (Paperback) - Common
