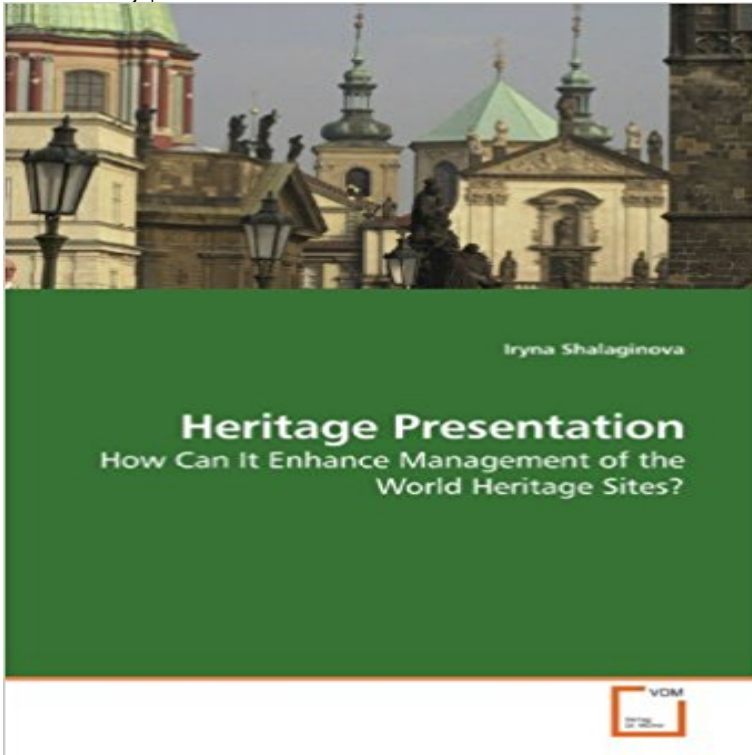


Heritage Presentation: How Can It Enhance Management of the World Heritage Sites?
