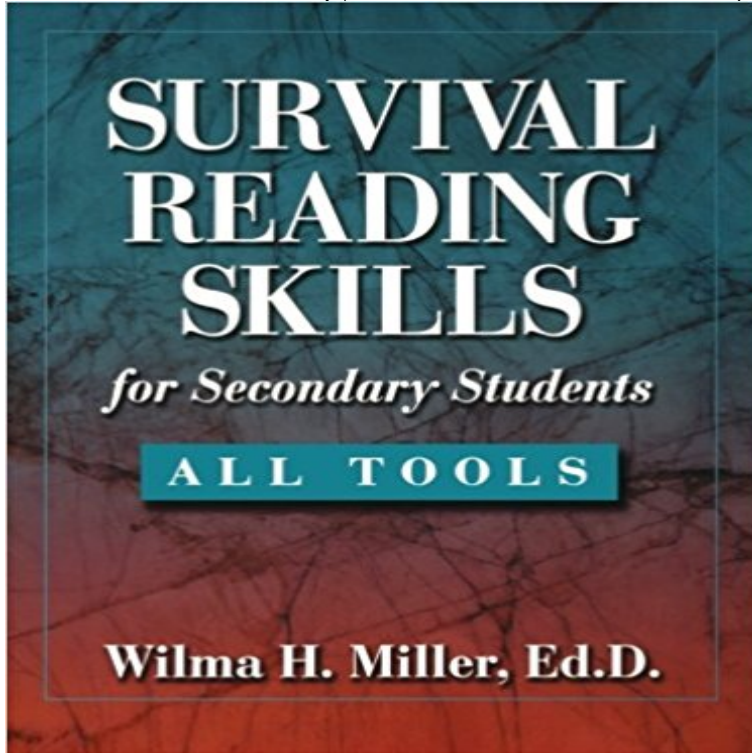


Survival Reading Skills for Secondary Students, All Tools
