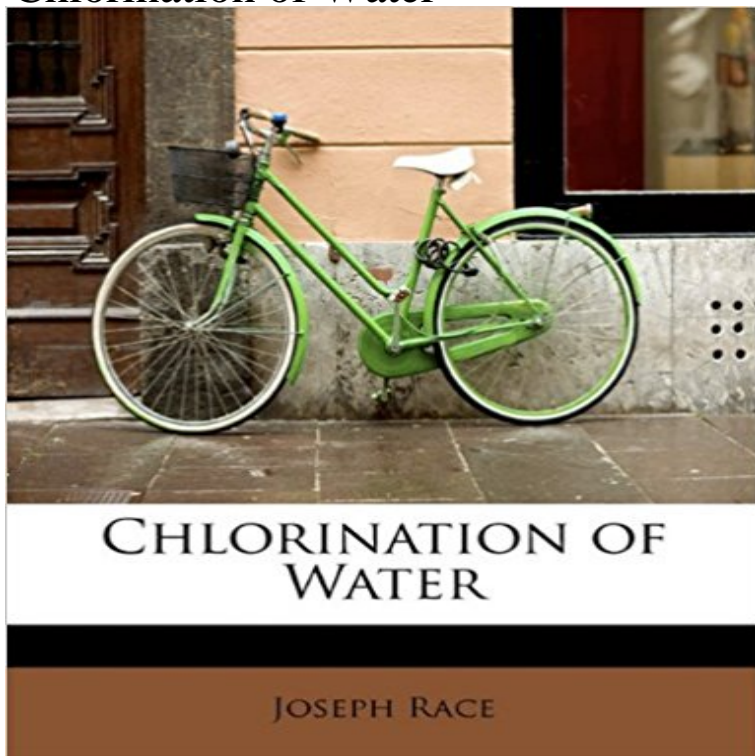


Chlorination of Water
