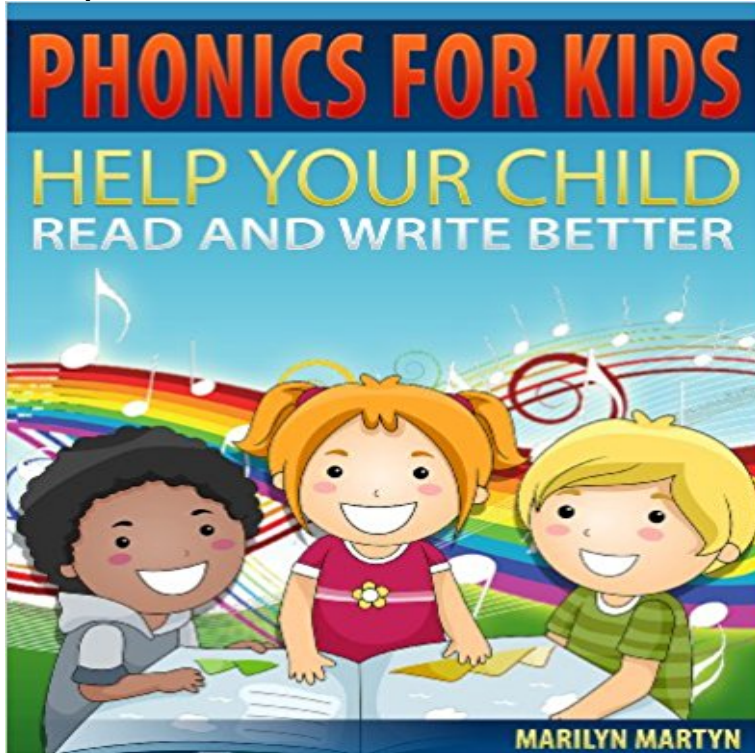


Help Your Child Read and Write Better
