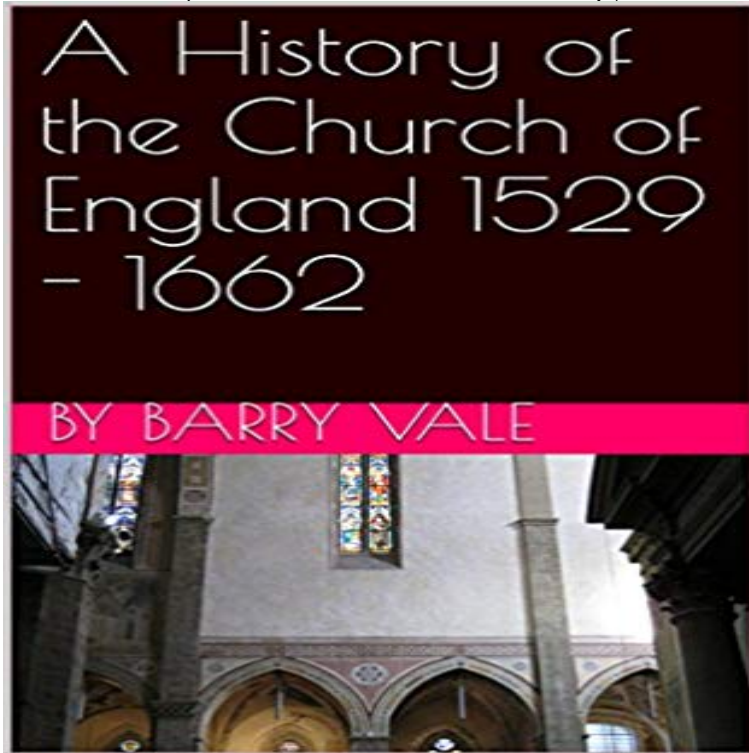


## A History of the Church of England 1529 - 1662
