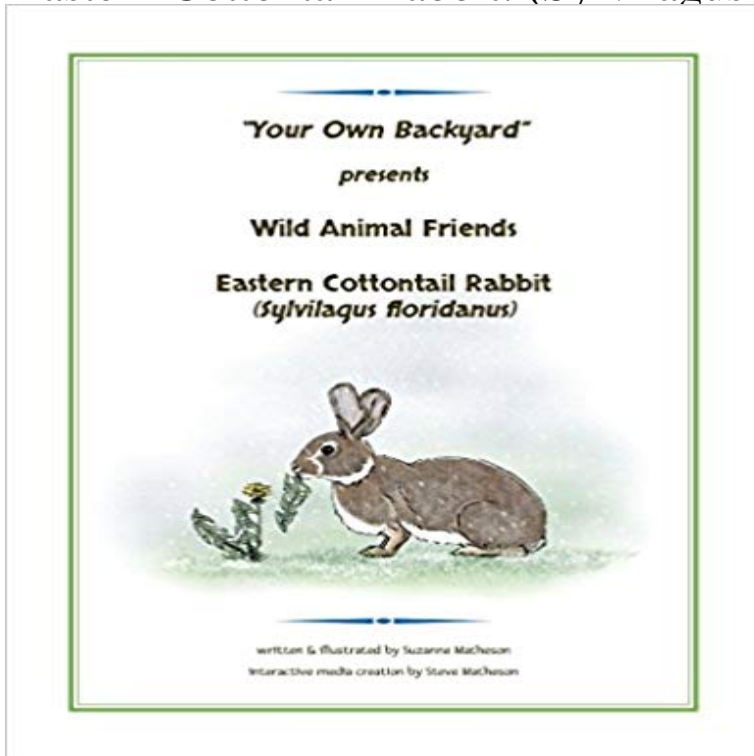


Eastern Cottontail Rabbit: (*Sylvilagus floridanus*)

The goal of this dynamic, indoor learning experience is to enhance awareness during outdoor exploratory learning through the development of nature connection skills combined with an eco-centric knowledge base. This is accomplished through the use of stories, online interactive slides and popup panels, creative activities, both cooperative and individual, as well as online interactive games. Links to online content are provided within this lesson handbook. The content is deliverable via SmartBoard, computer, or computer & projector. Structured as a 45-minute lesson, the amount and quality of information offers learning well beyond this time frame. Accessible from school and home, the online interactive Eastern Cottontail Rabbit Field Guide offers a unique supplementary learning opportunity and is highly suitable for use in a flipped classroom environment. While the online interactive content is enjoyable for all ages, the 45-minute lesson plan is designed for grades 2-5 (ages 6-11).
