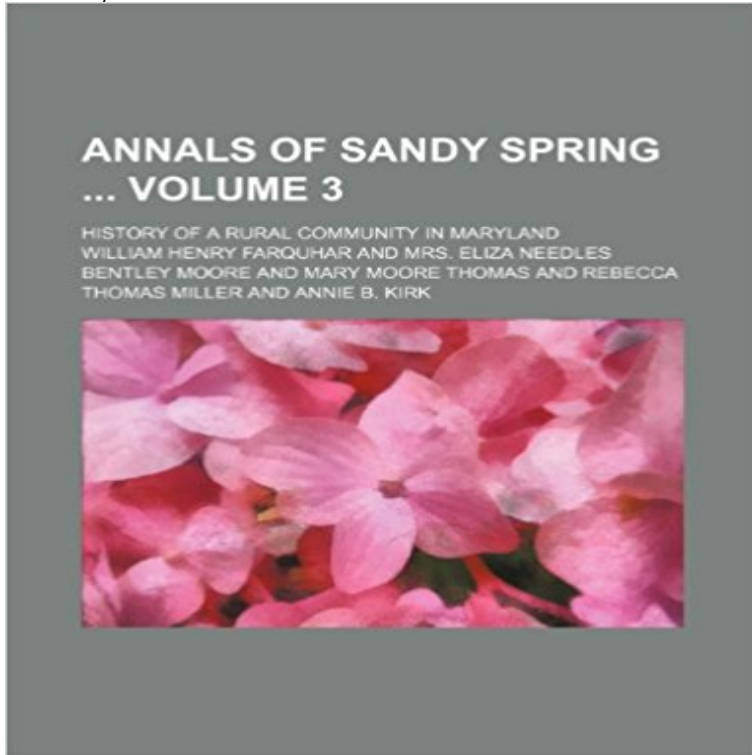

Open handed to a fault, he was always giving to others, often to the point of leaving his own needs unprovided for. His passion for fox-hunting was second only to his love for his profession, and he maintained various packs of hounds, in this State and in Florida. Graduated from the Naval Academy, in 1847, after serving as midshipman in the Mexican War, the outbreak of the Civil War found him a Lieutenant on the frigate Santee, where he immediately made himself conspicuous by his daring capture of the Confederate ram, Royal Yacht, off Galveston. The Navy Department, to express appreciation for so daring and successful an exploit, raised him to the command of the gun-boat Metacomet. In the battle of Mobile Bay he gained the

highest praise from Admiral Farragut, for his intr...
