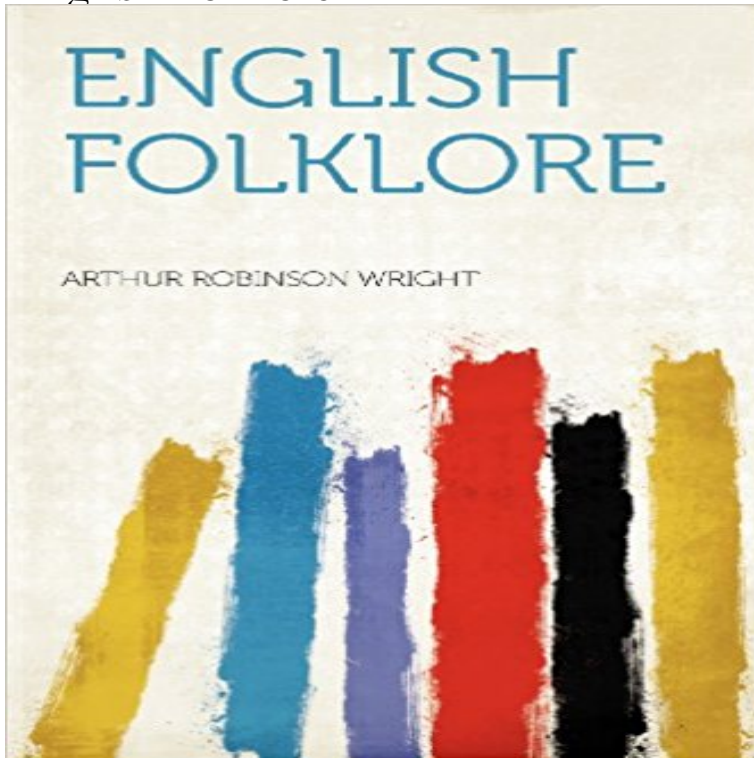


English Folklore
