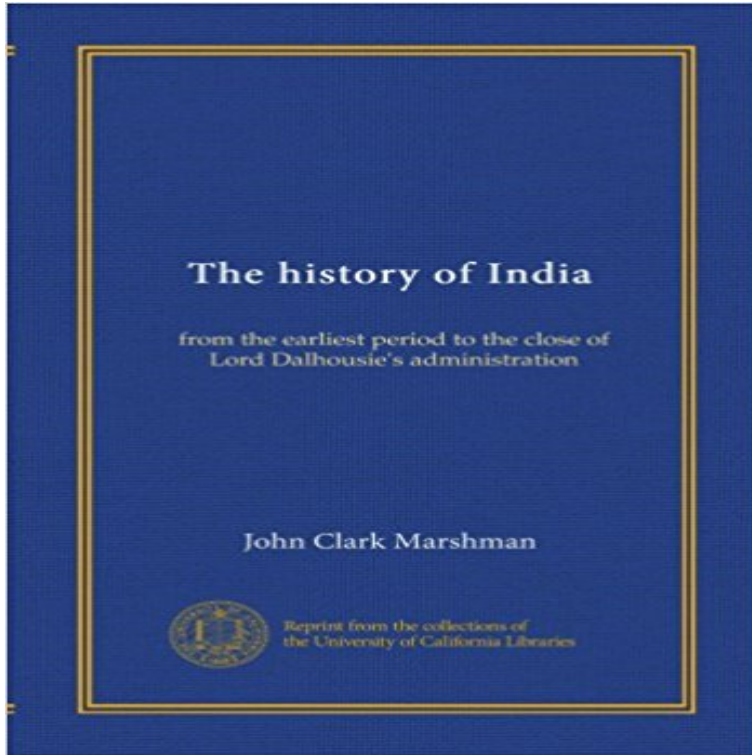


# The history of India (v.3): from the earliest period to the close of Lord Dalhousies administration
