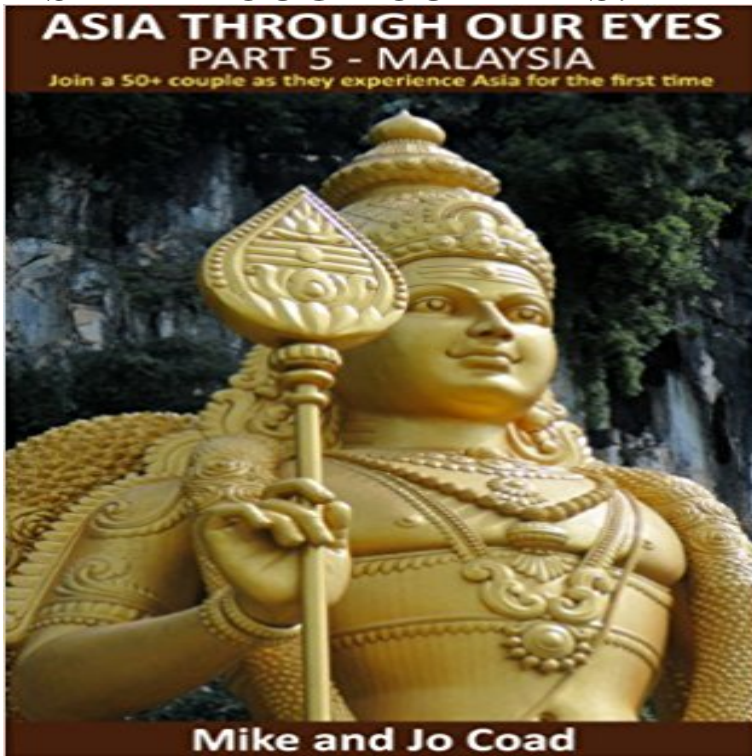


ASIA THROUGH OUR EYES: PART 5 - MALAYSIA
