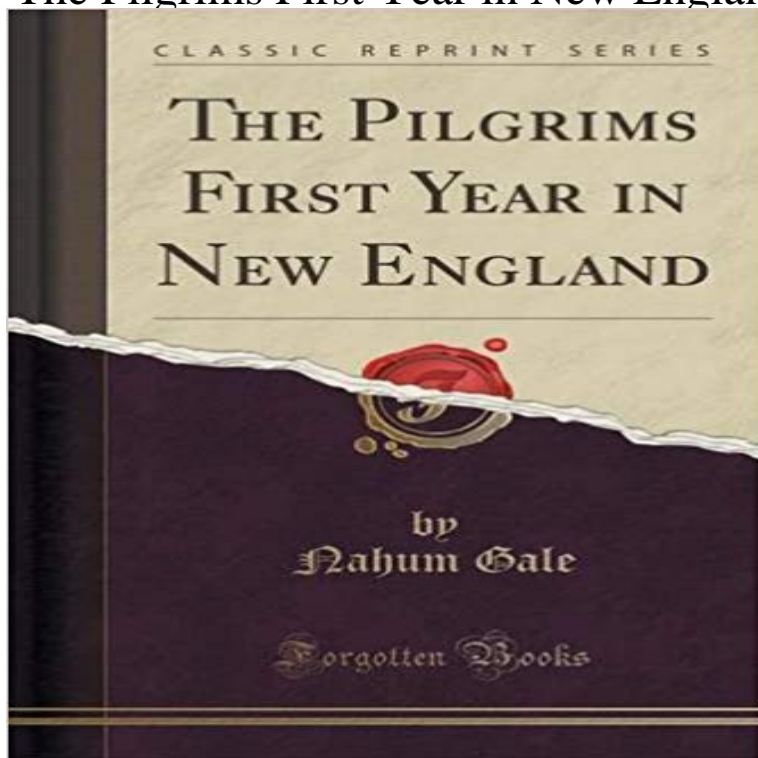


## The Pilgrims First Year in New England (Classic Reprint)
