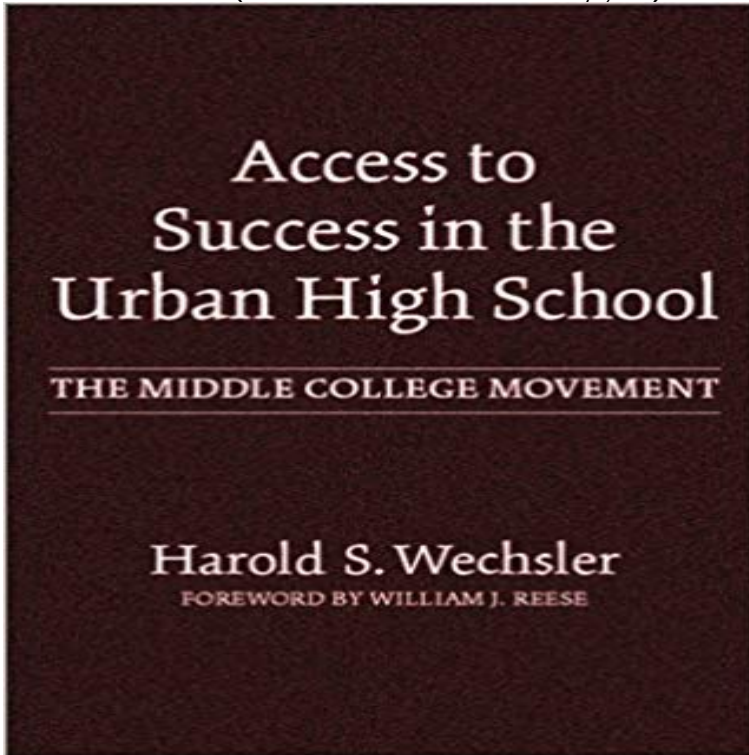


Access to Success in the Urban High School: The Middle College Movement (Reflective History, 7)
