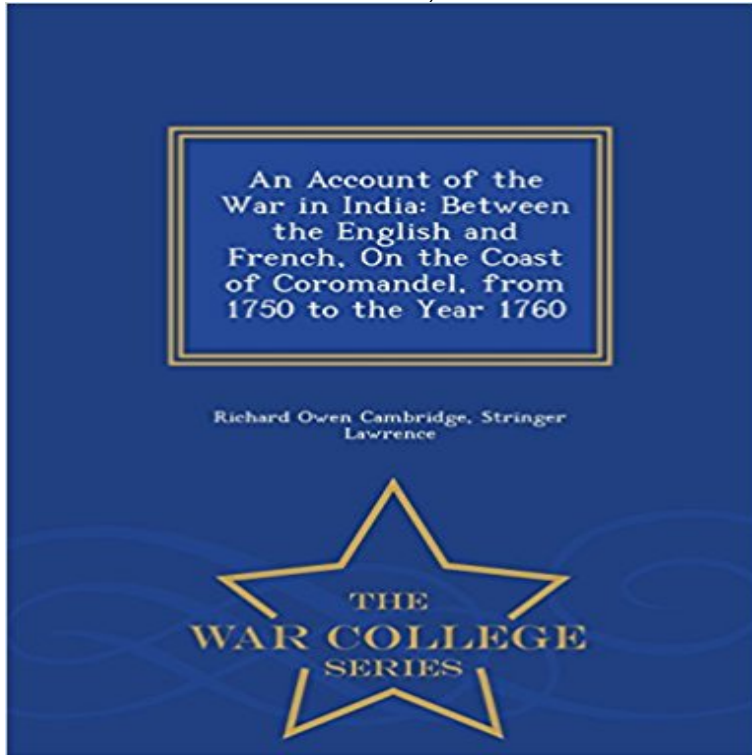


An Account of the War in India: Between the English and French, On the Coast of Coromandel, from 1750 to the Year 1760 - War College Series
